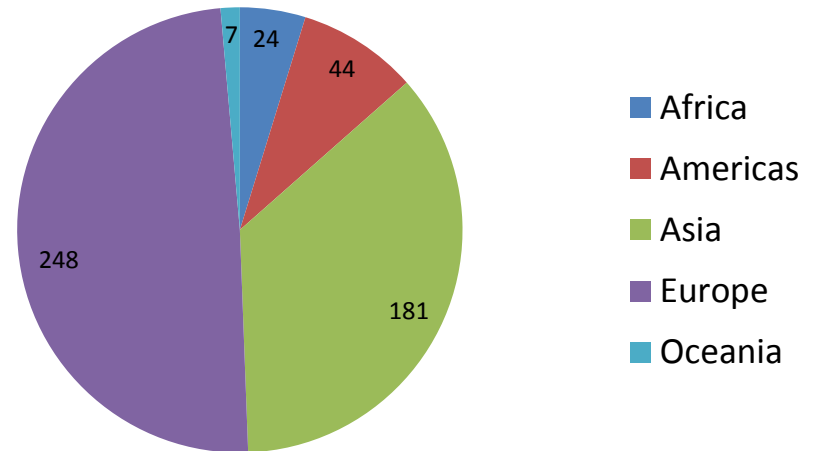

IUMI Tokyo - Attendees



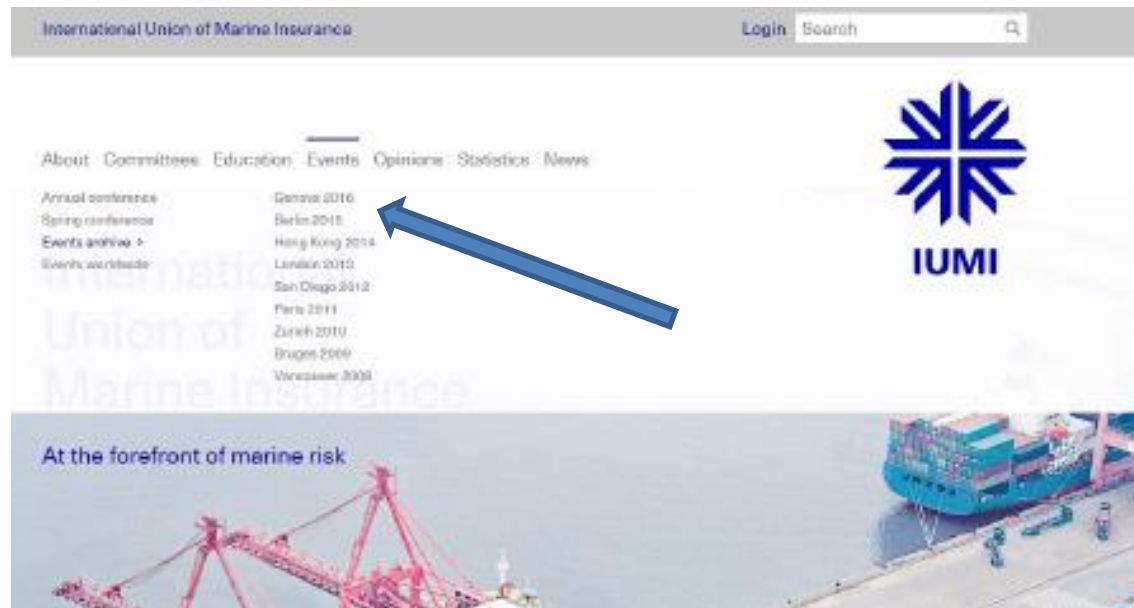
- 34 member associations represented + 3 observer from Myanmar
